Requirements for Discipleship

- Emotional maturity and stability
- Sincerity, honesty, willingness
- Understanding of the roles of guru and disciple
- Sufficient study and practice of Kriya Yoga
- Awakened discernment





Shankara on Discipleship

[There is a necessity for] discrimination between the eternal and the non-eternal; dispassion for the enjoyment of the fruits (of work) here and hereafter; a perfection of such practices as control of the mind, control of the sense organs, etc.; and a hankering for liberation.

—from his commentary on the *Brahmasutras*

- Viveka—Discrimination
- Vairagya—Dispassion
- **Shat Sampat**—Six virtues
- Mumukshuttva—Zeal for Liberation

- Uparama
- Titiksha
- Shraddha
- Samadhana
